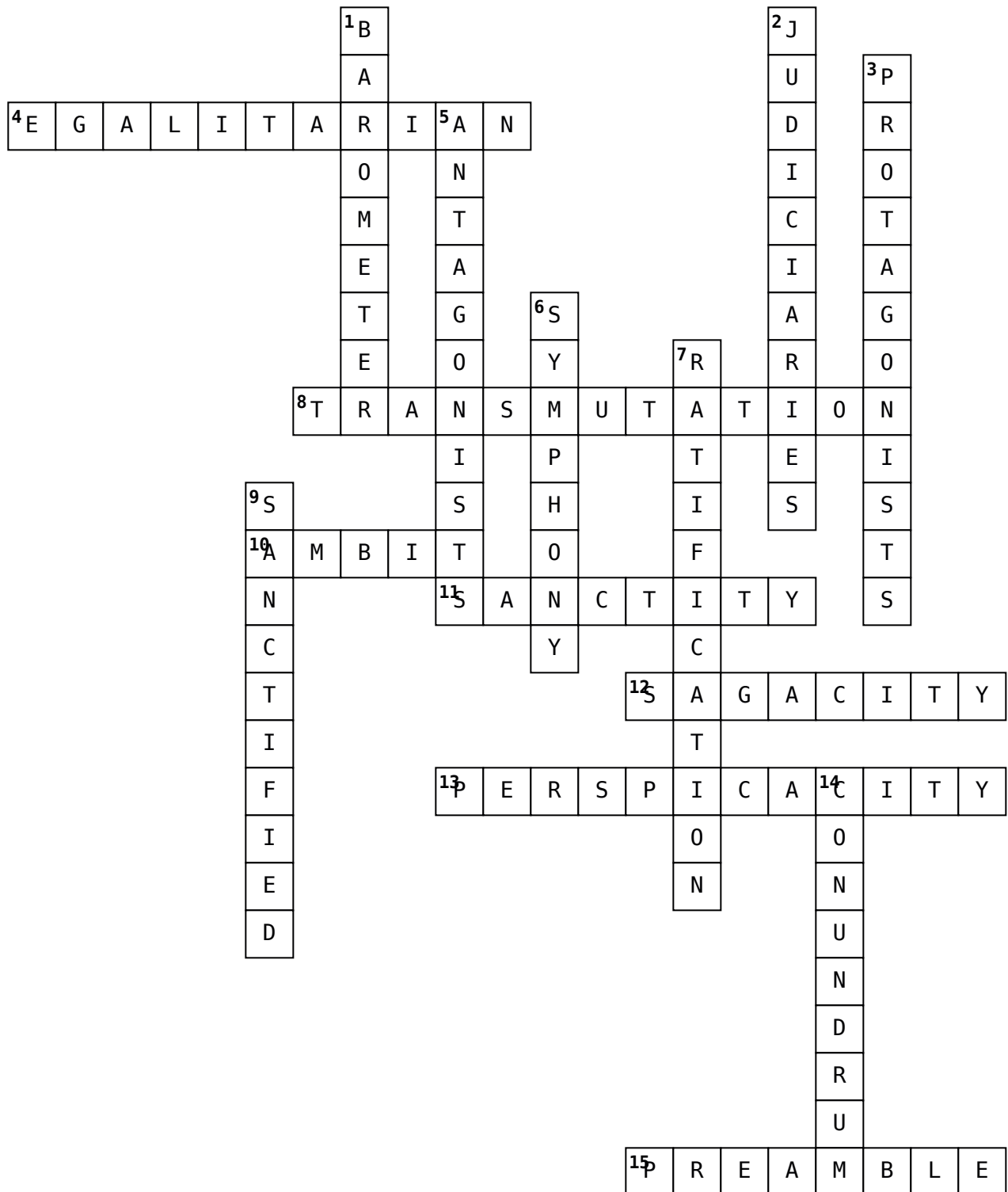


The Role of Government in Protecting Human Rights
