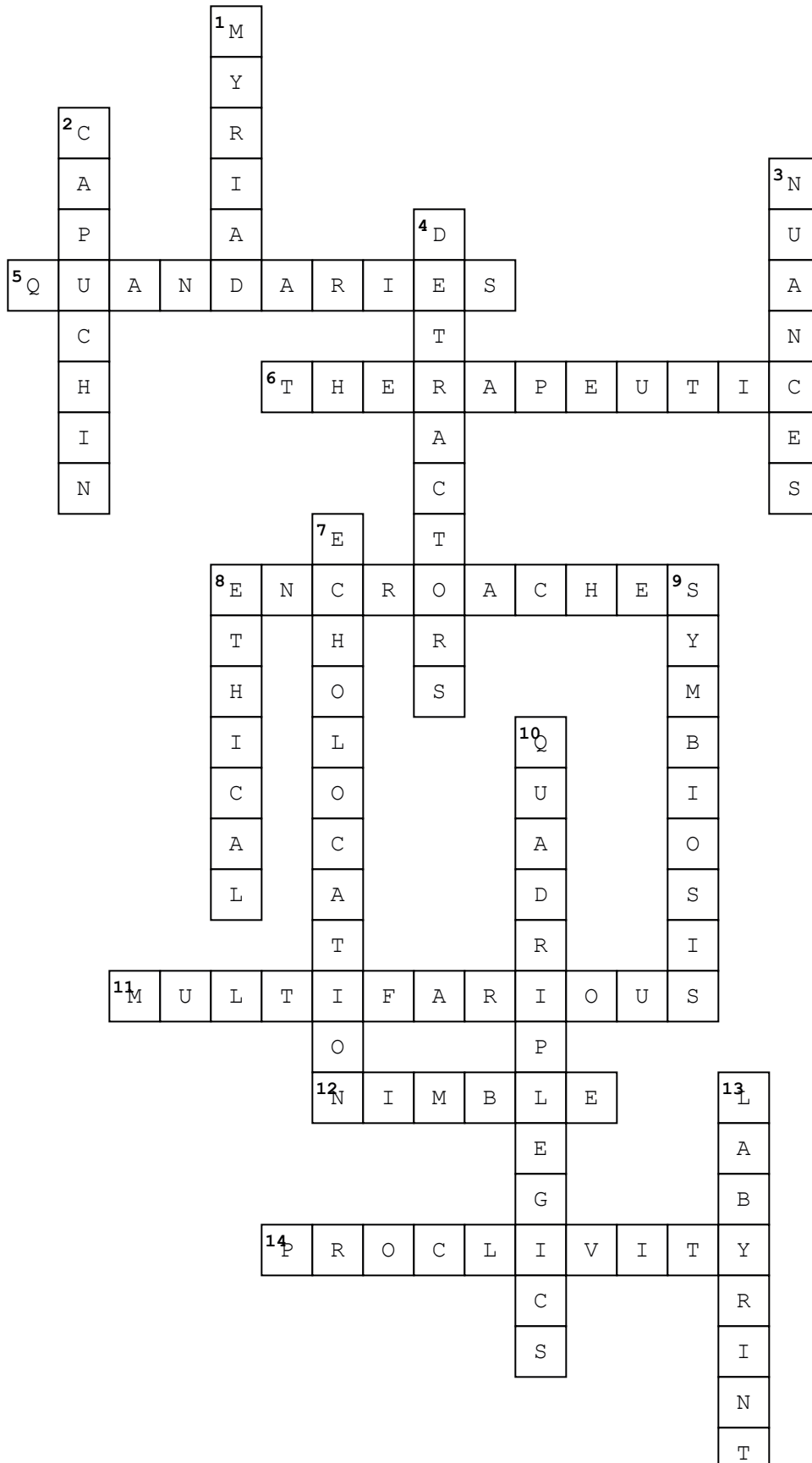


The Role of Service Animals in Helping People with Disabilities
